Term & Conditions for all Club Programmes

PARTICIPANT CONDUCT

- Franklin United Football Club Incorporated reserves the right to refuse registrations from any participant the Club feels will jeopardise the integrity of our Development Programmes.
- Players are expected to remain on the programme until completion, any player wishing to leave prior to the end of a programme will not receive any money back.
- All players registered with Franklin United Youth Academy are accountable for their behaviour and conduct. Any abuse (physical or verbal) against members of the public, staff, volunteers or other players will be treated with ZERO tolerance and will result in a player parent meeting with the Director of Football. Depending on the severity, a warning process will be actioned with a plan to support the player.
- Participants/Parents must contact Franklin United Football Club if the registered player is unable to attend the scheduled session, at least 2 hours prior to the session.
- All players must be prompt for all training sessions as stated in the programme timetable. Lateness/absences from training will result in the individual player missing the session and will be recorded and noted on your player parent meetings. Lateness/absence will also have an affect on the players competition playing time.
- Parents/guardians must inform the coaches if you remove your child during a session.
- Franklin United Youth Academy accepts no responsibility for any loss or damage to any personal property whilst attending any of our programmes.

ACCIDENT OR ILLNESS

- Franklin United Football Club or any of its coaching staff accepts no responsibility for any injury, death, loss or damage to the participant during any of our programmes. Parent(s) understand and are fully aware of the risks associated with their child participating in the activities provided by Franklin United Football Club and participate at their own risk and shall indemnify Franklin United Football Club and its staff and volunteers against all actions, suits, proceedings, demands, costs and expenses, which may be taken or made against the Club.
- Where a Parent is unable to be contacted or it is otherwise impracticable to be contacted, Franklin United Football Club is authorised for the adult in charge (i.e. Directors, Coaches, Volunteers or any Staff of Franklin United Football Club) to
 - Consent to your child receiving medical assistance as recommended by a medical practitioner in the event of any illness or accident.
 - Administer or consent to such first aid as the adult in charge may consider to be necessary in the case of illness or accident.
- If a player is seriously injured where an Ambulance is required, Franklin United Youth Academy and its officers will call for an ambulance if the player's Parent(s)/Guardian(s) are not immediately available to grant authorization at the cost of the player.
- It is the parents' responsibility to accept all risks involved in the administration of medical or first aid treatment considered necessary and the responsibility for payment of all expenses incurred in relation to such treatment and any emergency transportation required.
- You must disclose to Franklin United Football Club of any medical conditions the registered participant has where applicable on the registration form. Such information will be kept strictly confidential by Franklin United Football Club as is other personal information we may collect.

CANCELLATIONS/POSTPONEMENTS

- Franklin United Football Club will notify all Parent(s) via a SMS and/or email that a session is to be postponed or reschedule to another venue in the event of wet weather or extreme heat. The decision on whether a session will go ahead is made prior to the session, or in some circumstances the day before. Non-attending when a session has not been officially cancelled by Franklin United Football Club means the session is lost and no refund will be issued.

TRAINING & GEAR

- Franklin United Football Club may grade players into specific groups and this is at the discretion of Franklin United Football Club coaching staff and is dependent on the player's ability.
- Franklin United Youth Academy reserves the right to carry out the training sessions or not when the number of registered players is less than 12 participants.
- It is compulsory that all registered Academy players wear the Franklin United Youth Academy official uniform.
- Appropriate footwear (Trainers or football boots, depending on the surface) must be worn to ensure safety and maximum enjoyment.
- Shin pads are recommended for all children and are **COMPULSORY** for children aged 5 upwards.
- Franklin United Football Club is committed to being sun aware. The Club strongly recommends arriving with sunscreen already applied, and to have enough fluids for the duration of the sessions.

PAYMENT OF FEES

- Fees; due to the age of our Players (8 – 17), we only accept payment from a Parent or Legal Guardian of the person wishing to register with Franklin United Youth Academy.
- Once payment has been received no refunds will be provided except with prior written agreement from Franklin United Football Club. No refund will be given if you change your mind. If your child suffers a long-term illness such as a broken limb, or other extreme circumstances, please notify Franklin United Youth Academy straight away. Franklin United Football Club will consider putting accounts on hold or issue a credit at its discretion.
- Payment for all Programmes including the Academy must be paid prior to the start of the programme. Failure to do so will result in Franklin United Football Club personnel reserving the right to refuse participation of the player until such fees are paid.

PHOTOGRAPHS OF PARTICIPANTS

- Franklin United Football Club from time to time will take photographs and video footage of player during sessions and other events they may manage. By signing these terms and conditions, you acknowledge that Franklin United Football Club reserves the right to use such photographs and video footage taken of your child for use in publications, promotional material, on its website and its social media to solely promote Franklin United Football Club, unless you advise in writing that you do not wish for this to occur.

Franklin United Football Club reserves the right to amend these Terms and Conditions at any time. Any such changes will be effective immediately upon posting on the website. You should regularly check this page for any amendments.
